Artek was founded in 1935 by four young idealists, Alvar and Aino Aalto, Maire Gullichsen and Nils-Gustav Hahl. The business idea of the company was "to sell furniture and to promote a modern culture of habitation by exhibitions and other educational means." The founders of Artek advocated a new kind of environment for everyday life. They believed in a grand synthesis of the arts and wanted to make a difference in town planning as well as architecture and design.






Today Artek is renowned as being one of the most innovative contributors to modern design, building on the heritage of Alvar Aalto. Functionality and timeless aesthetics are the essential elements in the creation of every product that bears the Artek name. Artek's comprehensive furniture system is based on the original idea of standards and systems, which has its origin from Alvar Aalto's L-system. The standard and system thinking makes the furniture range versatile and allows it to be customised for individual projects. Artek's furniture can be found in various types of spaces; from public spaces to homes, museums to schools and hotels to offices.

The core of the Artek product range consists of Alvar Aalto's furniture and lighting pieces. Under its new portfolio strategy, Artek is looking to extend the range and, to celebrate the company's 75th anniversary in 2010, has acquired the rights to Ilmari Tapiovaara's furniture collection. In parallel, Artek also continues to work in close collaboration with prominent international architects, designers and artists, such as Eero Aarnio, Shigeru Ban, Naoto Fukasawa, Harri Koskinen, Juha Leiviskä, Enzo Mari and Tobias Rehberger.






In the 1940's, it was not possible to produce the large veneer seat/back rest element from one piece. Therefore, the chair is only now being produced as Tapiovaara originally designed it.







Tapiovaara had earlier used similar base structure as in the Tale stool in a coffee table designed in 1937. In the table the right triangular seat was replaced with a round top.

In the Finnish classic – the Domus chair – the basis was to be a true multi-purpose chair to meet the diverse needs of the Domus Academica student housing in Helsinki. It was to serve as a work chair in the student rooms, but also in the hallways, auditoriums, canteens, negotiation rooms etc. The Domus became a real success in Finland and the first remarkably exported Finnish piece of furniture was also produced with license in other parts of the world, for instance by Knoll International in the USA.



In the original Aslak chair Tapiovaara combined the solutions of his earlier designs of Domus and Lukki chairs. The contiguous back leg – armrest had already been sketched in 1946, but only in 1958 the new laminating methods of veneer made it possible for mass production. As it's predecessors Aslak got good reviews from the public and it quickly became a sales hit.

The Tee-Tee table was originally a unique design for the Finnish industrial art exhibition in 1940. Ilmari Tapiovaara had designed a living room furniture set including a sofa, armchair, cabinet, pendant light and a table – nowadays known as Tee-Tee – for the first prize of a lottery to be held after the exhibition.



In the 1950's alongside chairs Tapiovaara repeatedly made sketches for light and easy to move coffee tables. Another baseline in designing the Trienna coffee table was that larger honeycomb-like groups could be formed of them if needed. A few model versions were made in 1954, but the actual serial production only started in 2007. In 2008 The Wallpaper Magazine awarded the table the prize of "Best reissue table".


